#### UNDERPRIVILEGED

Underprivileged children often go to the worst schools too, which is another disadvantage.

FOSTERED

a child raised by someone who is not its natural or adoptive parent; a needy child, as one living in an impoverished country, supported or aided by contribution to a specific charity; a child without parental support and protection, placed with a person or family to be cared for, usually by local welfare services or by court order. The foster parent(s) do not have custody, nor is there an adoption, but they are expected to treat the foster child as they would their own regarding food, housing, clothing and education. Most foster parents are paid by the local government or a state agency.

#### **AT-RISK**



Separate Building Gates – Keyfob restricted to the building residents live in.


Front Door/Back Door/Garage: Keyfob restricted to the building residents live in.






